Uniform Information

What to know...

All marchers have now been fitted for uniforms. If your student needs Dinkles (\$30) or gloves (\$5), money can be deposited in the black box in the band room. PLEASE note your student's name and what the funds are for.

Students must wear close fitting clothes under their uniform. They all change clothes together in the band room. For football games, students must wear their show shirt and black compression shorts or pants. Basketball shorts or sweatpants are not permissible. Students must wear a black short sleeve or long sleeve compression shirt for competitions. Long socks (over the calf) are required for all performances.

All uniforms are stored at school. Students are responsible for keeping up with Dinkles. Dinkles should be well fitting and in good condition. They can be wiped down with Pledge wipes to keep them shiny.

Charms Calendar

All of the Marching Hawks dates are posted on the public Charms calendar. If you really on your phone calendar to keep you straight, you can sync the public Charms calendar to your phone and you'll never miss another event!

For iPhone users:

Go to Settings > Accounts & Passwords > Add Account

Select Other.

Under Calendars > Add Subscribed Calendar

Enter the public URL in to the Server field: <https://www.charmsoffice.com/charms/calsync.asp?s=HickoryHSBand>

Select Next. It will verify the server, then show a subscription page. You may change the description if you prefer. Select Save.

For Android users (or Google Calendar users):

On a real computer, in your calendar, under Other Calendars, select Add Link.

Select Add by URL.

Enter: <https://www.charmsoffice.com/charms/calsync.asp?s=HickoryHSBand>

Select Add Calendar. Google will begin to sync your calendar and it will appear on the screen.

Select Settings. Change the name of the Calendar to something you'll recognize (ie: Marching Hawks or Charms Calendar)

Your phone should sync with your Google calendar. Open Calendar on your phone, go to settings, select Calendar Sync, make sure Auto-Sync is checked.
