Your kids are busy!

The full schedule of events for this weekend is on page 2. As you can see, there are lots of moving parts and the kids are jam packed this weekend. The important stuff for parents to know are:

- Make sure your student has appropriate clothes for the weather. This includes snug fitting <u>long pants</u> and tight/compression style <u>long sleeve shirts</u> to wear under their uniform. Both must be black with no logos.
- Students will need to eat dinner before the football game Friday, pack a lunch for Saturday, and bring money for dinner Saturday and lunch Sunday.
- It's a LOOOONG day on Saturday. It's really important that students get adequate rest on Friday night and bring positive attitudes to school on Saturday.
- Ask your student about their "Secret Sibling"!
- Students are allowed to bring snacks on the bus. Drinks
 must have a cap (no pop tops or cans) and must be in
 plastic bottles. NO GLASS! They will be expected to
 clean up any mess before exiting the bus on Sunday.
- If you are traveling to JMU to watch the band, bring all your Marching Hawk spirit! It's going to be chilly and tends to be breezy in the mountains. <u>Spectator info</u> <u>can be found here</u> (bag checks, no stadium seats, no outside food & beverage). Tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for students.
