### HBPA Meeting, May 11, 2017

The meeting commenced at 7:02 p.m. Attendance: 75

The following reports were made:

Treasurer: Jeannet Barr filled in for Larry Weinstein. The Treasurers Report will be updated and posted soon. On the last Treasurers Report, it was noted that there was a line item “Donations – Toothman Fund” and the question was raised if part of that could be transferred to the scholarship line. A motion was made to move \$1383, seconded and approved.

Fundraising – Jeannet Barr outlined the status of the Raffle which included each student selling 10 tickets to get their name in a drawing for a gift card. This year 2200 tickets were distributed. Money and ticket stubs are due 5/12/17. Later in the meeting, details for the June 3<sup>rd</sup> Mattress Sale were covered by the CFS Fundraising Solutions representative, Nate Poe.

HBPA Bylaws – The bylaws have been updated by a committee over the past several months. The bylaws were last updated in 2006. In the upcoming weeks, the draft will be sent out for review. Responses will be accepted for 2 weeks and then voted on at the next full meeting.

CFS Fundraising Solutions Mattress Sale – Nate Poe discussed the fundraising potential for Hickory’s Marching Band through the upcoming mattress sale on June 3, 2017 from 10:00 – 5:00 in the Commons Area at Hickory High School. Over 2000 school groups such as bands and athletic teams across the country use the mattress sales and have raised over 20 million dollars for their groups. Hickory has the potential to raise thousands of dollars in a single day for the Marching Hawks. Materials were passed out for distribution, including flyers and posters with coupons and yard signs. Social media can also be used to promote the event. Banners will be placed in strategic locations in the area. On June 3<sup>rd</sup>, students as well as parents will be needed to greet and direct. Sales representative will be on site to speak with potential customers. Students referring potential customers will receive cash incentives.
